The project received its name because the streamlined construction for the star points was conceived while the designer was working at a quilt retreat in Rangeley, Maine. The wall quilt features a pieced 17" central star block surrounded by a cluster of 14 smaller stars in the borders. The construction techniques and the Tucker Trimmer Tool make this difficult looking project simple to construct.
